

August 18, 2006, Buena Vista, Colorado (AGM)

There was a USOF Board of Directors [meeting](#) held on 18 August 2006 in Buena Vista, Colorado, followed by the [Annual General Meeting](#) (AGM), followed by a second Board of Directors [meeting](#). The following summarizes actions taken at the two board meetings and the AGM.

1. The Board of Directors is currently investigating an appropriate policy for USOF to have in regards to criminal background checks for those working with youth in an official USOF capacity.
2. The 2007 Convention and AGM will be hosted by RMOC, 4-12 August 2007.
3. BAOC was awarded the 2007 Ski-O Championships to be held 3-4 February 2007.
4. A date change request was granted to QOC for the 2007 US Classic Championships. They are now scheduled for 3-4 November 2007.
5. BOK was awarded a WRE for one day of its event 2-4 March, 2007. This event is a US Team fundraiser.
6. CNYO was awarded the 2008 North American Orienteering Championships to be held either 26-28 September 2008 or 19-21 September 2008.
7. The Board approved a USOF Land Use Policy. The full text is available on the [USOF website](#).
8. The Rules Committee was directed to add M/F age classes of 75+, 80+, 85+ and 90+. The course for these classes will be Brown.
9. Invitations to juniors to join the Junior Development Team will be sent out shortly; those choosing to join will receive T-shirts.
10. Greg Lennon was elected as an At-Large member of the USOF BOD and Jerry Rhodes was elected as VP Marketing and Public Relations. Gary Kraght and Frank Kuhn were reelected to another term as VP Club Services and VP Club Development respectively.
11. Robin Shannonhouse was reappointed as USOF Executive Director for the next year.

The next BOD meeting will be 11 November 2007 in conjunction with the DVOA 'A' event in Batsto, NJ.
